RE: TGJA New Judges Fee Clarifications



Over the past several weeks of meets several questions have arisen regarding the new Judges' pay rates. These are the inevitable issues that arise when any new system is adopted. So that there is no confusion for judges and meet directors, the TGJA and the State Chair, after having numerous discussions, have determined formally, the following policies.

1. Number of judgments will be the number listed in the rotation schedule for each of the sessions as of the 1<sup>st</sup> Session of a meet. Any scratches that occur during the meet will still be considered as judgments. The Judges' Director of Officials will be responsible for getting those session numbers at the beginning of the event and informing the judges of the number in each session.
2. When a session is below 50 and has both Optional and Compulsory athletes, the rate for the judgments that make up the difference should be the average of the compulsory and optional rate used for that session.
3. A competition session that is structured as a traditional format, that incorporates a one touch warm up before each rotation will be considered a Modified Capital Cup format and those rates will apply.
